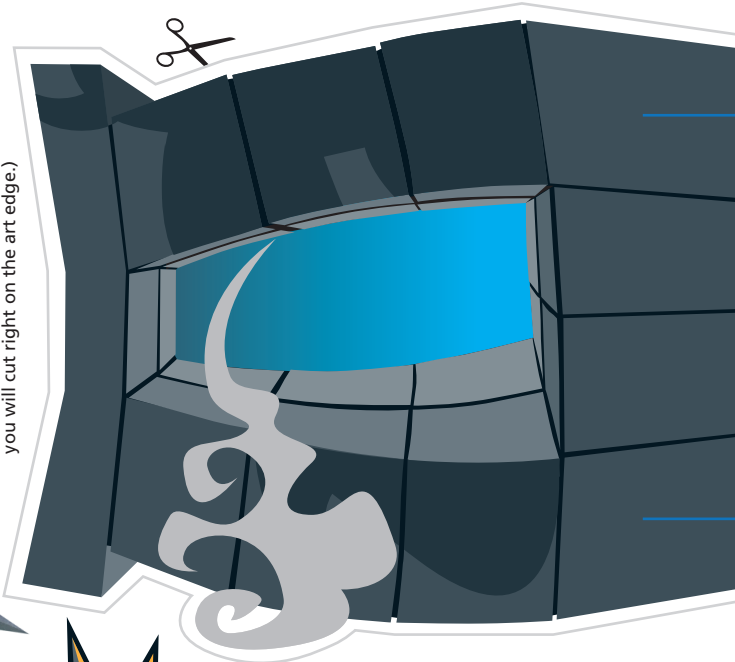

**LOOK!** You can have a Desktop Gremlin sitting on your desk in just a few short minutes! Print this page on **glossy photo paper** (for best results) and grab a pair of scissors!

**INSTRUCTIONS** Trim out the 3 pieces that form your gremlin as indicated. Don't forget to cut the assembly slots in each piece. Roll the "base" piece into a loop-type shape and secure by sliding the two vertical WHITE slots into each other. Insert the "background" and "foreground" pieces into the base by aligning the corresponding BLUE and RED slots.

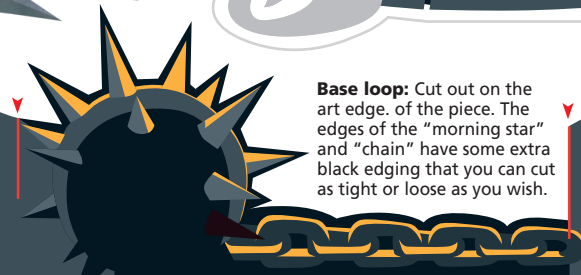


**Background piece:** Cut out on the GRAY lines surrounding the piece except for the bottom edge (which you will cut right on the art edge.)



See how you rotated this page around to read this text more easily? **Ge** The same rule applies to scissor cutting. Rotate the **Whiz!** PAPER while cutting—not the edges (and impress your friends!)

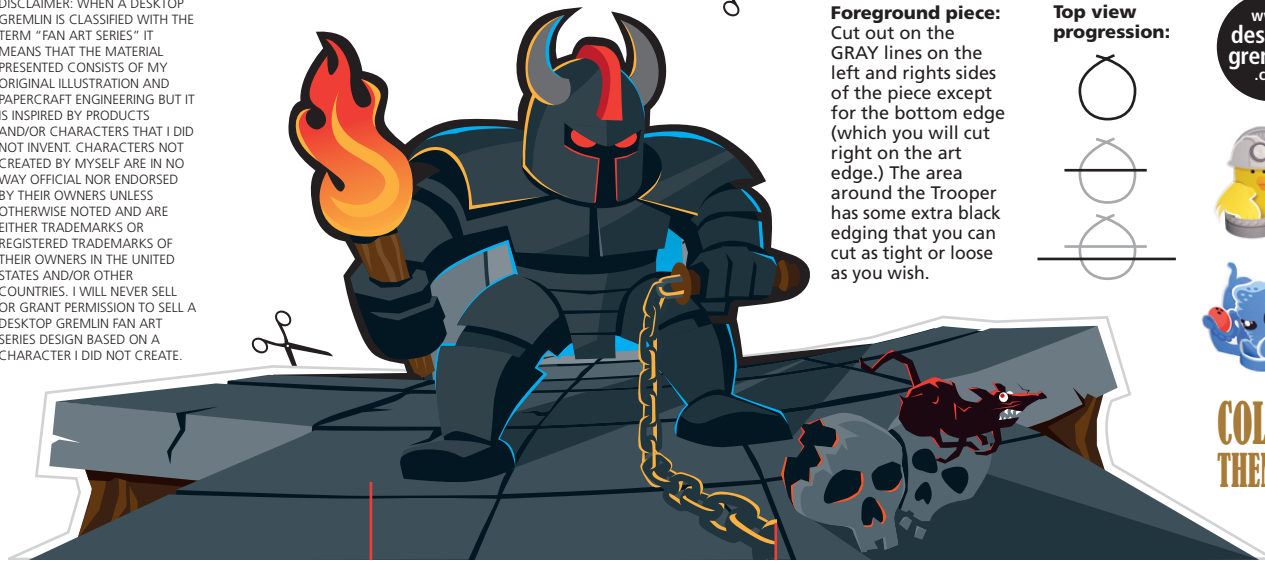

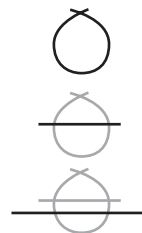
